

VNMAP Community Award

Purpose: Every year, VNMAP offers three awards of up to \$500.00 to individuals who demonstrate an interest in improving health services in and around their community, express a commitment to volunteerism, a dedication to academics, and a desire to develop professionally. This community award serves to provide financial support to VNMAP members in their academic and professional endeavors.

Eligibility:

- Commit to be an active VNMAP Member in some capacity
- High School, College, Post-Graduate Student, or young professionals

Requirements:

- Complete and submit an application outlining their community project and how it aligns with VNMAP's mission
- Submit a resume/CV
- Upon completion of their project(s), selected recipients must submit:
 - Project summary/report about how the community project adds value to our mission
 - Two high resolution photos documenting their project
 - Presentation about their project goals, challenges, successes, and lessons learned

Apply: All candidates must meet the minimum requirements and submit a completed application by one of three periods:

1. Winter Period: Deadline January 15
2. Spring Period: Deadline June 15
3. Fall Period: Deadline September 15

If an award is not given during one period then it will roll over to the next period.

Up to three VNMAP community awards will be offered annually. Candidates will be notified within a month after the deadline regarding the status of their application.
